

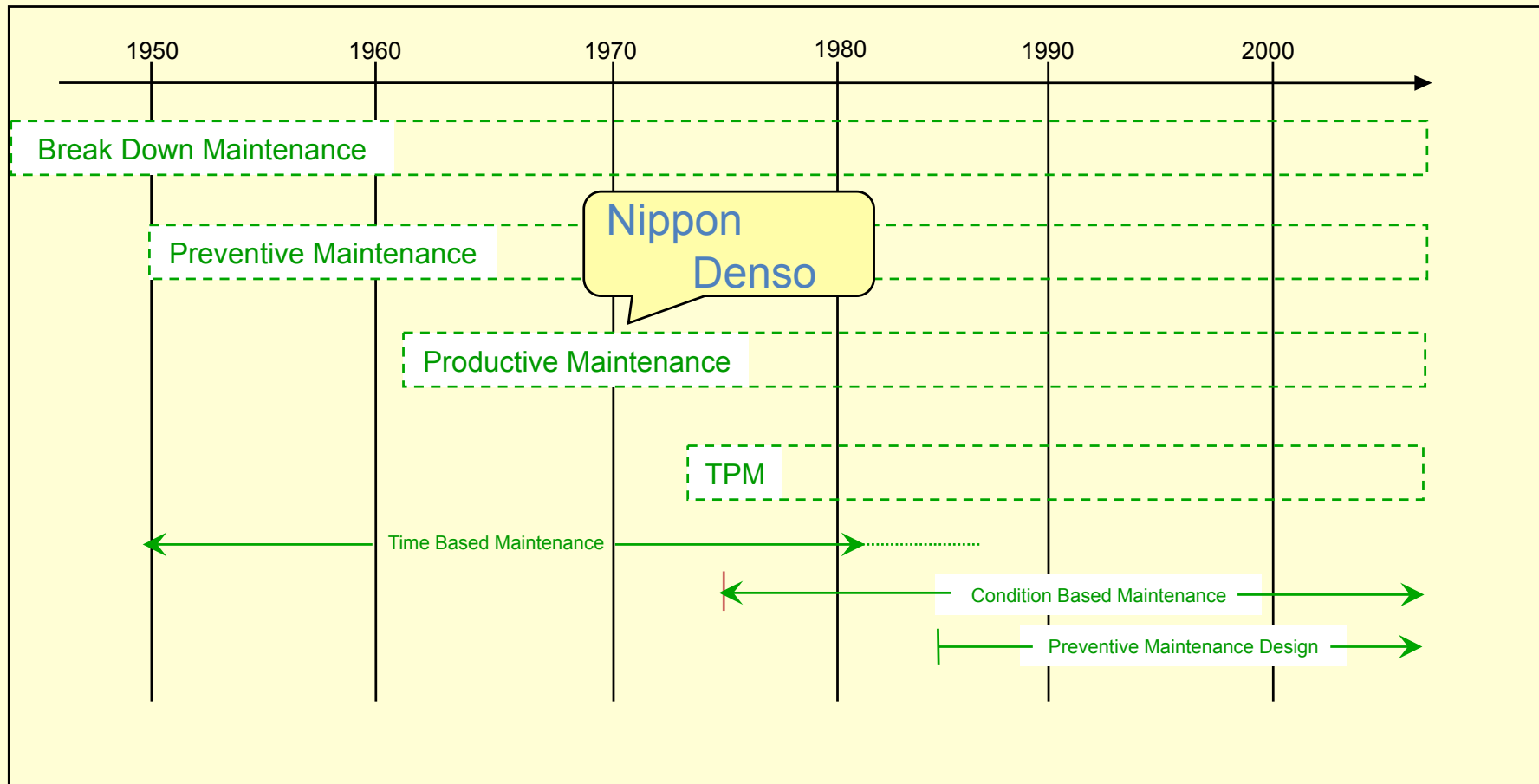

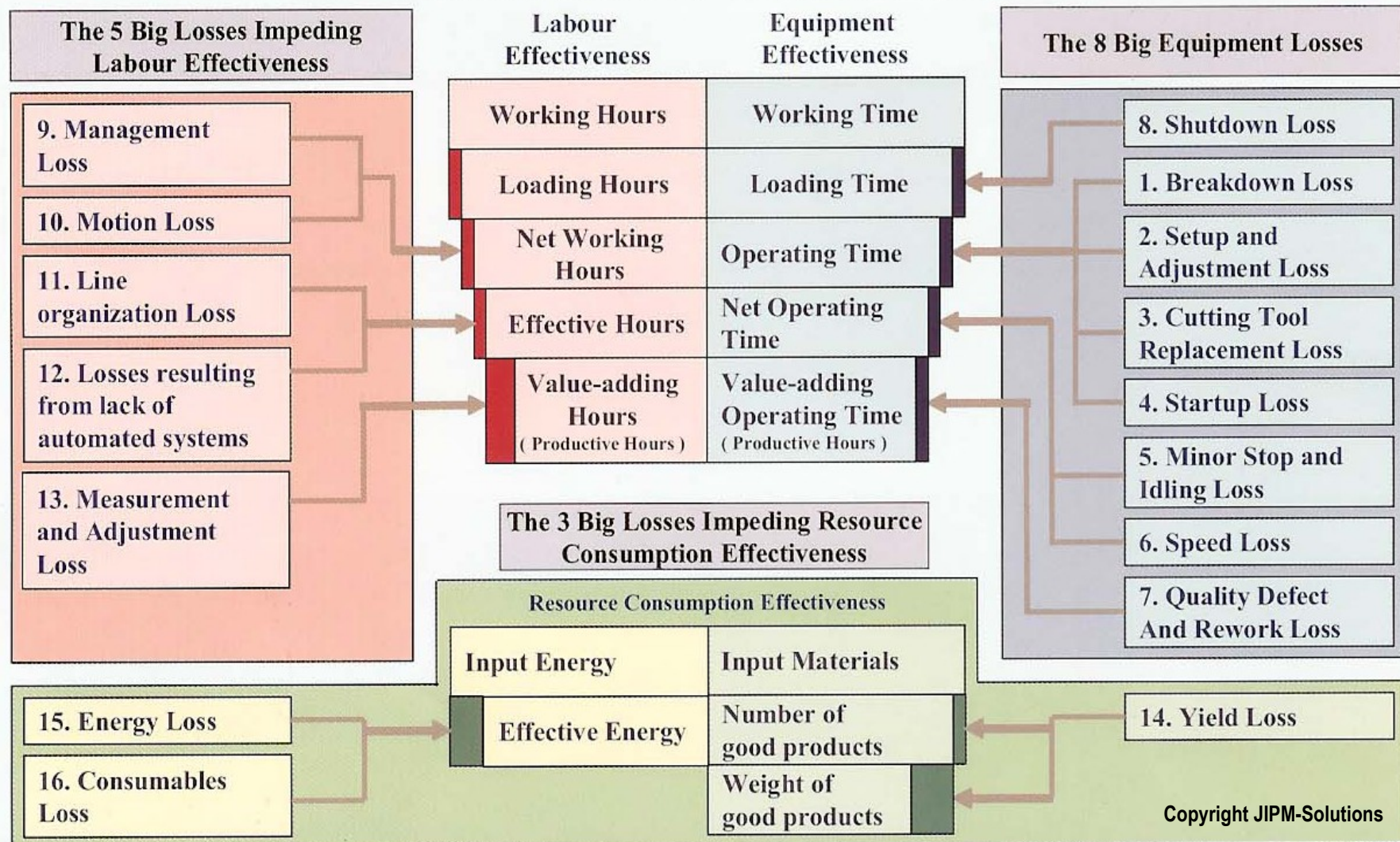

Evolution of TPM in Japan



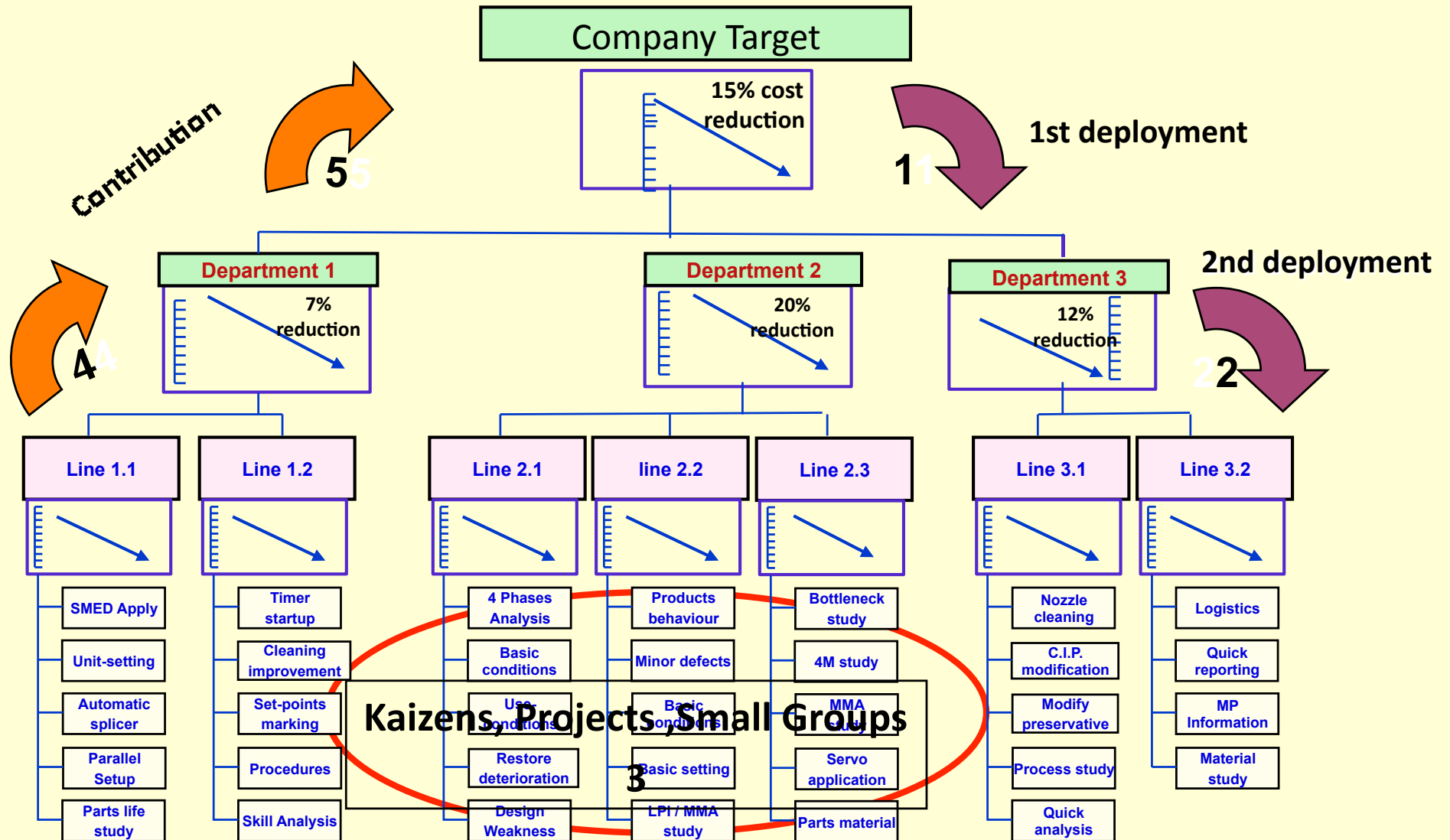

How The Losses Inherent in Production Systems (The 16 Big Losses) Are Structured



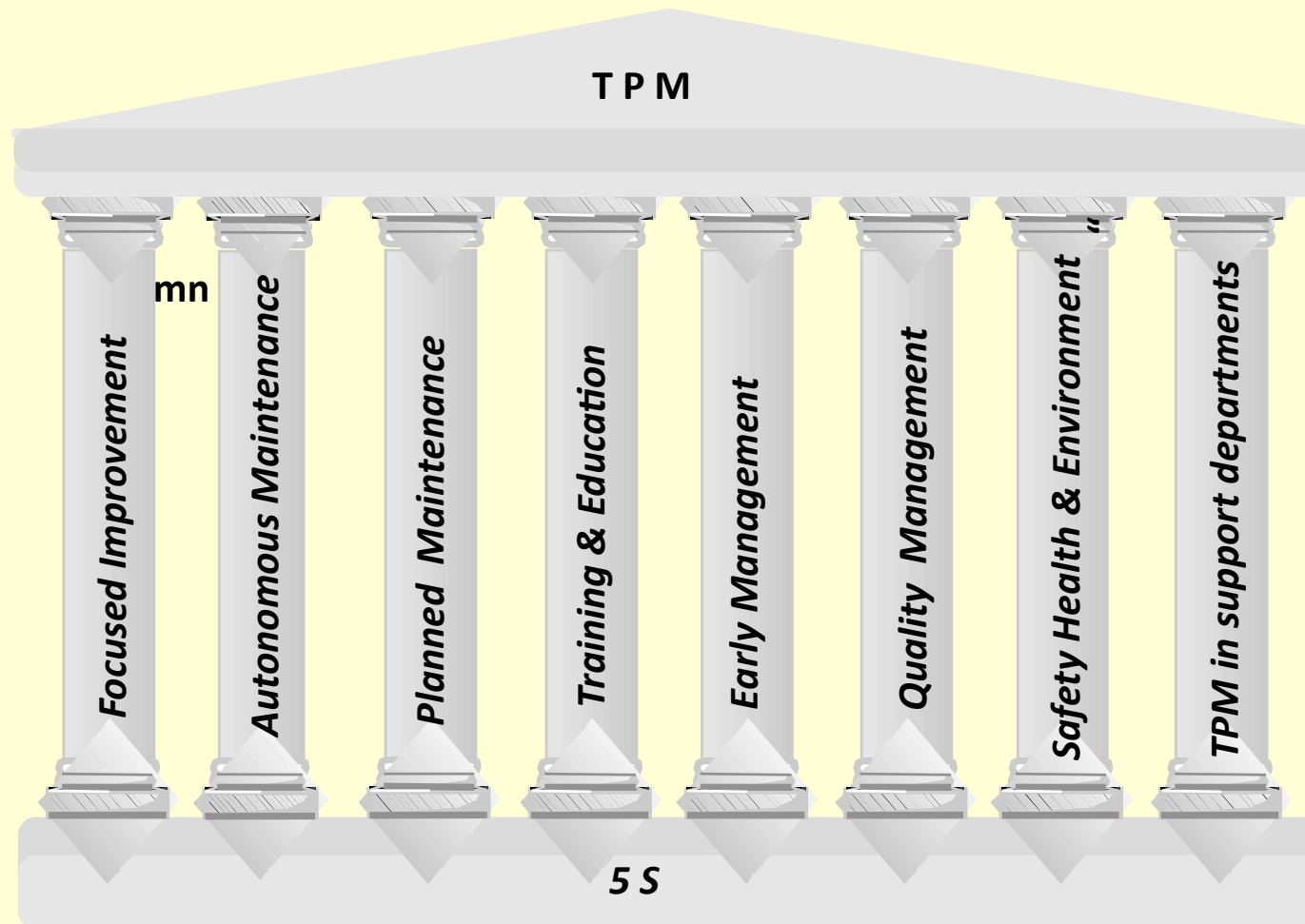
